		The PC reviewed the participation of II athletes from Australia and the potential inclusion of athletes from other countries. They emphasized the importance of aligning with IPC's recognition for II classification to ensure legitimacy and avoid past mistakes in recognizing athletes with intellectual impairments. Additionally, they discussed the possibility of providing technical assistance to II athletes but expressed the need to reassess the situation and understand how it's being done by IPC and other sports.
