Elite Athletes Lounge

Facilities including athletes' lounge are provided to the athletes at the venue of Sea Forest Waterway. Sealed bottles of water will be offered to the athletes before and after the race in the athletes' lounge.

Medical Services

First Aid and Emergency Medical Services will be available at the venue from 22 September until 23 September before and during the competition hours.


Medical and Paramedical personnel from JTU medical team will be available throughout competition times. Several ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfer to the event official hospital. A medical area will be provided in Sea Forest Waterway.

Possible medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatment at clinics and during practice is to be paid by the participants. Athletes/teams should ensure that they have appropriate medical insurance.



- 1. By Bus: Take a Toei bus from [Tokyo Teleport Sta. (01)] on Rinkai Line, and get off at [Kankyokyoku-Chubo-Godochosha (Environment government Offices)] and walk 20-min.
- 2. By Taxi: 20-min by taking a taxi from Shin-kiba Sta. on JR Keiyo Line (JE05), Subway Yurakucho Line (Y24) or Rinkai Line.
- 3. By Taxi: 15-min by taking a taxi from Tokyo Teleport Sta. on Rinkai Line.

Accreditation

LOC will provide all athletes, coaches, technical officials, medias, etc. with an official accreditation card according to the World Triathlon Event Operational and Technical Requirements.


