




3. VENUE: Taranto - Italy

3.1 <u>VENUE</u>

The venue is located in **S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School** - Via Mario Rondinelli, 26, 74121 Taranto.







3.2 PARKING

Parking available in "S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School" - Via Mario Rondinelli, 26, 74121 Taranto (free parking).

3.3 PARATRIATHLETE LOUNGE

Facilities, including the Athlete Lounge and restrooms, are located on the venue "S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School" - Via Mario Rondinelli, 26, 74121 Taranto (see the logistic map), 150 meters away from the parking lot. Sealed bottles of water are available for elite athletes prior to the race in the Athlete Lounge.

3.4 MEDICAL SERVICES

- First Aid, Emergency Medical Services, 4 Ambulances will be available to anyone requiring medical assistance at the venue, on Saturday June 8th
- Medical and paramedic personnel will be available throughout competition times.
- A Medical Tent will also be provided on site at the finish area
- Medical and paramedical personnel will be available throughout the competitions.
- Ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfer to hospitals.
- The Medical Tent will be located on-site near the finish line
- Medical services at the venue are free of charge.
- Only Team Medical Doctors with accreditations will be able to access these areas.
- Accreditations for Team Medical Doctors are given after the Athlete Briefing by the World Triathlon Medical Delegate to those who have registered with World Triathlon and have been approved in advance.
- Athletes/teams should ensure they have appropriate medical insurance documentation with them at the race venue.

5. TRAINING

5.1 SWIM COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Swim familiarization for paratriathletes will take place from 16h00 - 17h00 on Saturday, June 7th at the S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School, Via Mario Rondinelli, 26, 74121 – Taranto.

5.2 SWIM TRAINING

Swimming Pool: Mediterraneo Village (25m Indoor Pool) Via Francesco Bruno, 26, 74123

Distance race venue: 3,5 km

Free entrance athletes/coaches accredited in the official start list. ID document mandatory.

The Swimming Pool is available from Tuesday 4th to Friday 7th from 7h30 to 11h30. It is necessary to book because a maximum number of athletes (10) can access the structure at the same time (1 h) https://worldtriathlonparacuptaranto.makeplans.com/Note: no secure bike storage facilities.

5.3 BIKE COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Bike course familiarization for paratriathletes will take place from 14h00 to 14h30 on Saturday, October 28th at the S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School, Via Mario Rondinelli, 26, 74121 – Taranto.

Athletes should meet at Transition area.

During the familiarization the athletes will be escorted by the LOC and by the local police.

Vehicular traffic will be open but controlled.

After briefing, it will be possible to leave your bike inside the Athlete lounge until the race on Saturday.

5.4 BIKE TRAINING

Athletes can train around the city but be aware: roads are not closed from traffic. Athletes are cycling at their own risk, and traffic rules have to be respected.

5.5 RUN COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Run course familiarization for paratriathletes will take place from 15h00 to 15h45 on Friday, June 7th at the S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School, Via Mario Rondinelli, 26, 74121 – Taranto.

Athletes should meet at Transition area.

During the familiarization the athletes will be escorted by the LOC.

5.6 RUN COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

On the mornings from Tuesday 4 to Friday 7 June (9:00 am – 12:00 am), athletes will be



able to train on the athletics track, having free access to the "CENTRO SPORTIVO MARINA MILITARE via Cugini", via Cugini Giovanni, 50, 74121 – Taranto.

6. ACCREDITATION

- LOC will provide the official Accreditation Card to athletes, coaches, guides, team medical, technical officials, all the organizing committee members, VIPs, media, and volunteers, in accordance with World Triathlon Event Organizers' Manual (EOM) and World Triathlon Competition Rules.
- Athletes and Guide Accreditations will be included in the race pack that is going to be just after the athlete's briefing.
- Accreditation Cards are color-coded and provide access to specific areas of the competition venue.
- All accredited persons must always carry their accreditation card with them and show it upon request.
- All the other accreditations will be issued by the LOC at the Loc Office Friday the 7th from 16.00 to 19.00.
- Athletes and their accredited coach/support team must fill in the pre-event questionnaire prior to the race package distribution.
- If an athlete is not present and there is a waiting list, the athlete must be replaced according to standard procedures. The problem should be reported to World Triathlon Entries entries@triathlon.org

7. GENERAL COMPETITION INFORMATION



Warm-Up	Athletes may not warm up on the course on competition days due to use by other events. Swim warm-up time and location will be provided at the Athletes' Briefing prior to the competition.
Start	Athletes will start from a floating structure and stand in a starting position 70cm wide. The Race Referee, with the assistance of World Triathlon Technical Officials who are assigned to the start, will start each race.
Swim Course	The swim loop is 750m long, and athletes will complete one lap. The first turn is set at 280m. The average water temperature will be between 19-27°C (66,2°F – 80,6°F) The official water temperature will be taken one hour before each race start and posted in the Athletes' Lounge
Bike Course	There are five laps of 4,20 km each. Road are paved with good tarmac surfaces.
Run Course	Generally, flat course, with 2 laps of 2,5 km crossing the S.V.A.M. Military Air Force Volunteer School.
Wheel Stations	One wheel station will be located 300 m from the start of the bike lap (on the left side). Wheel must be checked – in and out at the Athletes' Lounge
Aid Stations	One Aid station will be located at the second turning point (towards the finish line) and one beyond the finish line. Sealed water bottles will be given.
Penalty Box	The penalty box for the transition area and the bike is on the right before returning to the transition area. The run penalty box is located just before the finish line.
Award Ceremony	As per the World Triathlon Competition rules 2.8 c.) (i), athletes must wear the uniform during the entire competition and award ceremony. Long sleeves and long pants are allowed for the award ceremony. Para athletes are not allowed to carry their country flag on the podium; there will be flags raising with the playing of the national anthem of the winner.

The athletes will be lined up in the water using a pontoon to which they can support themselves before the start.



7.5 WEATHER CONDITION

The climate in Taranto in June is between 21-29°C ($66,2^{\circ}$ F $-80,6^{\circ}$ F) and low precipitation. The heat stress index will be monitored during the competition days.






